ORDER


These appeals are from orders of the South Carolina Public
Service Commission (PSC). Numerous parties were allowed to intervene

before the PSC. Appellants ask this Court to determine the identity of the parties to their appeals. In addition, Friends of the Earth asks that the two appeals be consolidated.

The motion to identify the parties to the appeals is granted. The following shall be the sole parties in these appeals: South Carolina Energy Users Committee, Friends of the Earth, South Carolina Electric & Gas, and the Office of Regulatory Staff.

The motion to consolidate is denied without prejudice to the parties' right to renew the motion once the Initial Briefs and Designations of Matter are served and filed.
