4. Financial Capabilities

Applicant represents that it is financially able to furnish the services as specified in this Application. As a brand-new entity, the Applicant has not yet been capitalized such that it can provide the Commission with a financial statement or other document showing the current financial condition of the Applicant at this time. However, prior to obtaining financing for the operations of the Applicant, one of Applicant's shareholders will be helping to start the company. A recent personal financial statement for Roger Boyer is attached hereto at **Exhibit Two**. Applicant will supplement this Application with financial statements for the Applicant as they become available.

5. Proposed Rates and Charges:

The proposed rates and charges for service, and the terms and conditions governing same, are set out in the Applicant's Schedule of Rates and Charges, attached hereto as **Exhibit Three**.

6. Commodities to Be Transported and Area to Be Served:

(Household Goods, as defined in Commission R. 103-210(1)):

Between Points and Places in South Carolina.

7. Vehicles and Equipment:

Applicant intends to purchase two (2) new Freightliners to begin its moving operations, as well as related equipment. Applicant will update this Application upon the actual purchase of these vehicles and equipment, and will hold **Exhibit Four** open for that purpose.

8. Intrastate/Interstate Operation:

Applicant proposes to operate service applied for on an intrastate basis.

9. Operation and Intrastate Status:

The Applicant has not been certified to provide intrastate transportation of household goods in any other state. Applicant has not been convicted of operating with no intrastate household goods authority or for a failure to abide by the rules and regulations pertaining to the intrastate transportation of household goods in this state or any other state.

The Applicant has not had a certificate authorizing the transportation of household goods revoked in this state or any other state.

10. Insurance Quote:

Applicant attaches as **Exhibit Five** a copy of a quote for liability and cargo insurance.

11. Statements of Fit, Willing and Able

- a. Applicant does not possess a safety rating from the U.S.D.O.T.;

- e. The Applicant is aware of the Commission's insurance requirements and the insurance premium costs associated therewith.

12. Applicable Statutes and Rules and Regulations:

Applicant is familiar with the provisions of S.C. Code Ann. § 58-23-10, *et seq.* (1976, as amended), and R. 103-100 through R.103-241 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations for Motor Carriers (Vol. 26, S.C. 





**REGULATIONS AND SCHEDULE OF CHARGES APPLICABLE TO
CERTAIN INTRASTATE HOUSEHOLD GOODS MOVES WITHIN THE

Applicability of Tariff

This tariff contains the regulations and rates applicable to the provision of intrastate household goods moved by Two Men and a Truck of Florence. These services are furnished between points and places in South Carolina.

SECTION 1

1.0 TRANSPORTATION CHARGES

Transportation Charges include the hourly rates as listed below.

1.1 Hourly Rates and Charges

Moves will be conducted on a “straight time” basis, with a minimum hourly charge as set out below plus actual travel time. The clock starts at the appropriate hourly rate when the movers leave the Two Men and a Truck of Florence office location, and the clock stops when the movers return back to the office once they have unloaded at the customers’ new home.

Hourly Rates – Weekdays (Monday – Thursday)

Hourly rate per one mover, residential --	\$74.00/hour
Hourly rate per two movers, residential --	\$108.00/hour
Hourly rate per three movers, residential --	\$142.00/hour
Additional movers: \$35.00/hour	

Hourly Rates – Weekends (Friday, Saturday and Sunday)

Hourly rate per one mover, residential --	\$90.00/hour
Hourly rate per two movers, residential --	\$124.00/hour
Hourly rate per three movers, residential --	\$164.00/hour
Additional movers: \$41.00/hour.	

Additional trucks over one will be billed at the rates set forth above.

1.2 Minimum Hourly Charges

Customers will be charged a two-hour minimum, and then in fifteen-minute increments thereafter. If customers cancel within 48 hours of their move, Two Men and a Truck of Florence will charge the applicable minimum.

SECTION 2

2.0 ADDITIONAL SERVICES

The following charges shall be assessed in addition to the hourly rates quoted in Section 1.1 of this tariff.

2.1 Bulky Article Charges (per item)

2.1.1 Hot Tubs

For moving a hot tub, alone or along with other household goods, there is a fee of \$150.00 in addition to the appropriate hourly rate as set forth in Section 1.1 above. The two-hour minimum does apply when moving a hot tub alone.

2.1.2 Fire-proof file cabinets and safes

For moving a fire-proof fire cabinet or safe, alone or along with other household goods; there is a fee of \$90 (first floor to first-floor only unless an elevator is available) in addition to the appropriate hourly rate as set forth in Section 1.1 above. The two hour minimum does apply when moving any of these items alone.

2.1.3 Other Bulky Items

Any bulky articles not listed above will be charged the same as the appropriate hourly rate.

2.1.4 Right to Decline to Move Items

Two Men and a Truck of Florence reserves the right to decline, at its sole discretion, to move particular items because of their bulk or fragile nature. No slate top pool tables will be moved, unless they are fully disassembled prior to arrival.

2.2 Piano Charges

2.2.1 Spinet, console or studio pianos:

For moving a spinet, console, or studio piano, alone or along with other household goods, there is a flat charge of \$75.00 in addition to the appropriate hourly rate as set forth in Section 1.1 above. The two hour minimum does apply when moving a spinet, console or studio piano alone.

2.2.2 Upright pianos (48 inches or taller)

For moving an upright piano (48 inches or taller), alone or along with other household goods, there is a flat charge of \$90.00 in addition to the appropriate hourly rate as set forth in Section 1.1 above. The two hour minimum does apply when moving an upright piano alone.

2.2.3 Baby grand pianos

For moving a baby grand piano, alone or with other household goods, there is a flat charge of \$120.00 in addition to the appropriate hourly rate as set forth in Section 1.1 above. The two hour minimum does apply when moving a baby grand piano alone.

2.3 Elevator or Stair Carry

Two Men and a Truck of Florence does not charge an additional fee for elevator or stair carry. The charges are the same as the appropriate hourly rate.

2.4 Excessive Distance or Long Carry Charges

Two Men and a Truck does not charge customers an additional fee for carrying articles an excessive distance, long carry charges, articles, or special serving. These charges are the same as the appropriate hourly rate.

2.5 Packing and Unpacking

We are not responsible for items packed by the customer. Boxes containing fragile or breakable items must be properly labeled. We reserve the right to decline any moves consisting of extremely large or fragile items.

2.6 Articles, Special Servicing

The rates and charges in this tariff do not include servicing or connection of appliances such as freezers, refrigerators, computer equipment, washers, dryers, televisions, and similar articles.

2.7 Waiting Time

Customers will be charged for waiting time the same as the appropriate hourly rate.

2.8 Holding Fee

If customer needs items held on a truck for more than four (4) hours on a scheduled move day, the customer will be charged a flat fee of \$150.00. In addition, the customer will be charged \$150.00 for each additional day that Two Men and a Truck holds items on a truck for the customer.

SECTION 3

3.0 RULES AND REGULATIONS

3.1 Claims

All claims for loss, damage or overcharge must be written and should be attached to the Bill of Lading. Claimant must immediately notify carrier of all claims for concealed damage. Two Men and a Truck of Florence must be given reasonable opportunity to inspect damaged items in original packing.

Although our movers will be careful with your possessions, from time to time damages may occur. If damages are caused by our service, we reserve the right to repair the damage(s) in question. If we determine that damages cannot be repaired, we reserve the right to either replace or compensate (actual cash value) for the damage. If there is damage, notify us immediately. 


