

Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC, Duke Energy Progress, LLC, and South Carolina Electric & Gas Company (together, the Utilities) have filed a Joint Application with the Public Service Commission of South Carolina (the Commission) Regarding the Implementation of S.C. Code Ann. Section 58-39-110, the South Carolina Distributed Energy Resource Act (Act 236 or Act) and for Approval of Revised South Carolina Interconnection Standard. The Utilities are each engaged in the generation, transmission, distribution, and sale of electric energy at retail in South Carolina, and, accordingly, are public utilities under the laws of South Carolina subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission and the Act. The Joint Application was filed pursuant to S.C. Code Ann. Section 58-27-460 and 10 S. C. Code Ann. Regs. 103-823.

Act No. 236 of 2014 directs the Commission to promulgate standards for interconnection of renewable energy facilities and other non-utility-owned generation with a generation capacity of 2,000 kilowatts (kW), measured in alternating current (AC), or less to an electrical utility's distribution system. The Application states that the Act also requires the Utilities to review the renewable energy facilities and other non-utility generators' interconnection requests and to determine whether the customer-generator has met the requirements of the newly-adopted Commission standard. Exhibit One of the Application contains a proposed interconnection standard which was created as a result of collaborative work by the Utilities and input and contributions of several stakeholders which are mentioned on pages four and five of the Joint Application.

The Joint Application requests that the Commission approve the Proposed Standard under S.C. Code Ann. Section 58-27-460(A) as reasonable and appropriate to achieve the purposes of the Act and to approve the proposed reporting and queue update requirements outlined in the Joint Application.
