Subject: Request for Additional Information (RAI) in PSC docket 2016-334-E

Please deliver additional information vital to restore justice for SC victims: peoples, businesses, state and federal economy.

1. The Permanent Evacuation Plan for millions of South Carolinians in the case of Nuclear Disaster in VC Summer Nuclear Plant containing Units 1, 2 and 3. What is and would be your organization's participation?
2. The water inflow records before and after the Parr Reservoir on the Broad River, especially in the years 2000-2002. The records should indicate measuring stations and data in the smallest available increments.
3. Alarm systems for indication of radiation released to air and water from VC Summer as well as Duke Carolinas nuclear station projects upstream from the Broad / Congaree River. Redundant Governors decision making headquarter organization.
4. What were punitive fees for FERC P-1894 license violations, specifically in 2000 - 2002, and who paid them?
5. What was, and what will be Greater Columbia's water demand and consumption in first decade of the 21<sup>st</sup> Century and predictions until 2080?
6. How many years of cooling three reactors in Jenkinsville location have from the Monticello reservoir in the case of damage supply from the Broad River?

7. How fast could be damaged reactors covered by sarcophagi to avoid extension of radiation zones?
8. AP 1000 reactor has protection against a large aircraft hit, what is the same protection for dams and their elements in the water path in hydro-turbines on Parr and Monticello reservoirs?
9. Who blocks a criminal investigation in SCANA white-collar crimes? If you cannot or do not want to indicate these, especially legal professional names, give date and actions taken to restore justice and return stolen money from electric ratepayers with switching any costs of the investments to, for example, federal funds?
10. Who removed and/or blocked state bills for criminal responsibility and whistleblowers' rights to compensation and criminal responsibility of white-collar criminals?
11. What was the reason (geo? engineering? others) of moving location of some plant constructions' location in initial works on Duke's site for new Lee Nuclear Station from rock geo-structures?
12. Show the scientific calculation for safety reasons in VC Summer location on or close to earthquake centers and also "transmission of seismic waves zones/ lines".
13. How certain are Parr and Monticello reservoirs to be heat sinks for three units after 72-hour internal cooling systems. Compare to known Chernobyl and Fukushima cases as well as China's Sanmen project.
14. LIP for the Broad River with perspective new large users i.e. Duke and SCE&G nuclear plant projects before 2007.
15. What are resonance frequencies of VC Summer seismic hazard carrying structures comparing to recorded incite frequencies from epicenters in Union, SC, Charleston SC, and St. Anna, VA
16. The list of politicians and scientists who received SCANA donations / contributions since 2005 till now.
17. The number of all/total SCANA (NYSE:SCG) shares with especially detailed number and values of shares issued, their notation since 2001 till now.
18. In the situation when millions of SC victims are robbed by SCANA since 2008, we the victims have rights to receive scientific and legal support in requesting more information even after your answers and our logical/scientific reviews complicity the problems.
