Dear Ms. Boyd:

By letter dated March 7, 2016, SC Solar Development, LLC ("SCSD") submitted comments in the above-referenced docket and requested that the Public Service Commission of South Carolina ("Commission") "carry over this matter." The purpose of this letter is to inform the Commission that South Carolina Electric & Gas Company ("SCE&G") has reviewed SCSD's comments and opposes the delay requested and disagrees with SCSD's basis for challenging the pending interconnection procedures. The proposed procedures enjoy broad support from the South Carolina Office of Regulatory Staff ("ORS"), the South Carolina Solar Business Alliance, LLC (of which NARENCO is a member), and the joint applicants in this proceeding. There is simply no substantive justification for delaying the approval of the proposed interconnection procedures. Accordingly, SCE&G respectfully requests that the Commission proceed with ruling on this matter today and approve the joint application as supplemented by ORS in its letter dated February 26, 2016.
