This matter comes before the Public Service Commission of South Carolina (“Commission”) on Application of DG Delivery Services, LLC for the transfer of Class E (Household Goods) Certificate No. 9747 and sale of assets from Danny Grantham d/b/a DG Delivery Services to DG Delivery Services, LLC. The Application was filed on June 29, 2016, by Transferee DG Delivery Services, LLC, a South Carolina limited liability company that was created on June 6, 2016, for the purpose of this transfer and sale. By Purchase of Business Agreement (“Purchase Agreement”) dated May 27, 2016, Transferor Danny Grantham d/b/a D.G. Delivery Services sold to Docugraphics, LLC, also a South Carolina limited liability company, all of its assets including Certificate No. 9747 (PSC Order No. 2005-58) that grants authority to transport household goods between points and places in Charleston, Berkeley and Dorchester Counties to points and places in South Carolina. Thomas Fimian is the sole member of both Docugraphics, LLC and Applicant. By Bill of Sale and Assignment dated June 23, 2016, Docugraphics, LLC assigned all of its right, title, and interest in the Purchase Agreement and Bill of Sale to Applicant.

The Office of Regulatory Staff submitted a letter on August 22, 2016, informing the Commission that it supports the Application and does not intend to participate in this Docket. On September 6, 2016, the Applicant filed a Motion for Expedited Review. As there are no other parties to this matter, and the Office of Regulatory Staff supports the Application, we grant the Motion for Expedited Review. Furthermore, we find and conclude that the Applicant meets the requirements for the transfer of a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity as specified by 26 S.C. Code Ann. Regs. 103-135.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

Based on the above information, including the verified testimony of Danny Grantham and Thomas Fimian, we approve the transfer of Certificate No. 9747 and sale of assets as detailed in this Order.


This Order shall remain in full force and effect until further order of the Commission.
