HEARING EXAMINER ACTION:

Charter Spectrum (Charter Communications) moves to dismiss the above-referenced complaint. In connection with its Motion to Dismiss, Charter Spectrum requests holding the filing deadlines for all parties and hearing date in abeyance until such time as the motion may be considered and resolved by the Commission.

This request does not prejudice any party to the docket. Therefore, the request is granted. If the Motion to Dismiss is denied, the Hearing Examiner will establish a new schedule for filing testimony and reschedule the hearing.
