DOCKET NO. 2016-224-E - South Carolina Electric & Gas Company's Annual Request for Revised Rates - Staff Presents for Commission Consideration the Petition to Intervene Filed on Behalf of Charter Communications, Inc.

COMMISSION ACTION:

This matter comes before us on a Petition to Intervene filed by Charter Communications, Inc. in the SCE&G Nuclear Rate Revision case, which was filed under the Base Load Review Act. Charter's Petition states only that Charter has an interest in the proceeding, and gives other general information. SCE&G filed a reply to the Petition, which requests denial of Charter's Petition, based on alleged non-compliance with certain provisions of the Base Load Review Act, specifically S.C. Code Sections 58-33-280 and 58-33-285. These sections provide a specific procedure that must be followed with regard to requests for approval of revised rates under the Act. Section 58-33-285 notes that any aggrieved party may petition the Commission for review of an issued revised rates order within thirty days of issuance of that Order, and that that party must identify with particularity the specific issues it intends to raise with regard to the revised rates order.

In the present case, I have reviewed the Petition, and Charter did fail to identify any specific issues that it would raise, even if the Petition to Intervene was construed to be a Petition for Review of the issued revised rates order. I agree with SCE&G that Charter's Petition does not comply with the Base Load Review Act, and, for that reason, I move that Charter's Petition to Intervene be denied.
