 Requesting Approval to Amend Tariff) AMENDED TARIFF

This matter comes before the Public Service Commission of South Carolina (“Commission”) on the Application of Bill Sanders Moving, Inc. (“Sanders Moving,” “Applicant” or “Company”) to amend the Company’s current tariff. Sanders Moving presently holds a Class E Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to transport household goods in South Carolina pursuant to the authority granted by this Commission.

Upon receipt of the Application, the Commission’s Clerk’s Office instructed Sanders Moving to publish, one time, a Notice of Filing in newspapers of general circulation in the affected areas of the state. The purpose of the Notice of Filing was to inform interested parties of the Company’s Application and of the manner and time in which to file the appropriate pleadings for participation in the proceeding. The Company complied with this instruction and provided the Commission with proof of publication of the Notice of Filing. No protests or petitions to intervene were received.

By its Application filed August 22, 2016, and as amended on August 25, 2016, Sanders Moving seeks approval to increase certain rates and to make various changes to other charges and terms and conditions of the Company’s current tariff.

The South Carolina Office of Regulatory Staff (ORS) completed a review of the proposed tariff and submitted its findings to the Commission on September 16, 2016. From the comparison report completed by ORS of the tariff modifications proposed by Sanders Moving to the South Carolina Tariff Bureau's (SCTB) rates, it appears that some of the rates are below the SCTB rates while others are above, where a comparison rate is available. Although certain of the proposed rates are above the SCTB rates, we note that no other parties have filed in opposition to the rates proposed by the Applicant. Further, ORS advises of its approval of the tariff as submitted by Sanders Moving. Lastly, according to ORS's review, the Company is currently in compliance with all Commission rules and regulations and filing and reporting requirements, and no complaints have been filed against the Company within the past twelve months.

Having considered the Application, the lack of opposition and the results of the ORS impact study, we conclude that the amended tariff proposed by Sanders Moving is just and reasonable for the Company and its customers. Accordingly, the Company's Application to amend its current tariff should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

1. The Application of Bill Sanders Moving, Inc. to amend its tariff is approved as filed, subject to compliance with all applicable statutes, rules and regulations. The approved revised tariff is attached as Order Exhibit 1.


2. This Order shall remain in full force and effect until further order of the Commission.



**REGULATIONS AND SCHEDULE OF CHARGES
APPLICABLE TO CERTAIN INTRASTATE
HOUSEHOLD GOODS MOVES WITHIN THE
STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA**

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APPLICABILITY OF TARIFF

This tariff contains the regulations and rates applicable to the provision of intrastate household goods moved by Bill Sanders Moving, Inc. These services are furnished between points and places in the State of South Carolina.

SECTION 1

1.0 TRANSPORTATION CHARGES

Transportation charges include the hourly rates as listed below.

1.1 HOURLY RATES AND CHARGES

Moves will be conducted on a "straight time" basis, with a minimum hourly charge as set out below plus actual travel time. The clock starts at the appropriate hourly rate when the movers leave the Bill Sanders Moving, Inc. office location, and includes the movers estimate return time to the office location.

1.2 OFFICE HOURS / MINIMUM HOURLY CHARGES

Bill Sanders Moving, Inc. will operate Monday – Friday, 7:30 a.m. – 6:00 p.m. and Saturday, 7:30 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. and Sunday by appointment only.

Monday – Friday	Two-Hour Minimum Rate Charge
Saturday – Sunday	Two-Hour Minimum Rate Charge
Recognized Federal Holidays	Three-Hour Minimum Rate Charge
Emergency Requests	Three-Hour Minimum Rate Charge

After the minimum hourly charge, the hourly rates are calculated in fifteen-minute increments. Any interim charge is rounded up to the next fifteen-minute increment. If customers cancel within 48 hours of their move, Bill Sanders Moving Inc. will charge the applicable minimum. Hourly rates are the same, seven days a week, 24 hours a day, in every season of the year. Customers are not charged an additional fee for overtime labor.

SECTION 2

2.0 ADDITIONAL SERVICES

The following charges shall be assessed in addition to the hourly rates quoted in Section 1 of this tariff, in connection with a move involving additional items:

2.1 BULKY ARTICLE & ADDITIONAL CHARGES (PER ITEM)

Mileage in excess of 30 miles but less than 60 miles from Anderson, SC Office	\$95

2.2 ELEVATOR OR STAIR CARRY

Bill Sanders Moving Inc. does not charge an additional fee for elevator carry, but does charge an additional fee for stair carry as specified in Section 2.1 above.

2.3 EXCESSIVE DISTANCE OR LONG CARRY CHARGES

Bill Sanders Moving Inc. does charge an additional fee for carrying articles an excessive distance to or from the motor vehicle as specified in Section 2.1 above. Bill Sanders Moving does charge an additional fee for transporting articles in excess of 30 or more miles from Anderson, SC office as specified in Section 2.1 above.

2.4 PICK UP AND DELIVERY

Bill Sanders Moving Inc. does charge an additional fee for making additional pick-ups and additional deliveries after the initial stop as specified in Section 2.1 above.

2.5 PACKING AND UNPACKING

- *2.5.1 Bill Sanders Moving Inc. does not charge an additional fee for packing and unpacking. The packing rate is the same as the hourly rate listed in Section 1; plus the market price of packing materials.*
- *2.5.2 Bill Sanders Moving Inc. is not responsible for items packed by the customer. Boxes containing fragile or breakable items must be properly labeled. Bill Sanders Moving Inc. reserves the right to decline any moves consisting of extremely large or fragile items.*

2.6 PIANO CHARGES

Bill Sanders Moving Inc. does charge an additional fee for transporting pianos of any make/model as specified in Section 2.1 above.

2.7 ARTICLES, SPECIAL SERVICE

The rates and charges in this tariff do not include servicing or connection of appliances such as freezers, refrigerators, computer equipment, washers, dryers, televisions, or similar articles.

2.8 WAITING TIME

The customer is charged the rates specified in Section 1 for all waiting time or delays which are not the fault of Bill Sanders Moving Inc.

SECTION 3

3.0 RULES AND REGULATIONS

3.1 Claims

- 3.1.1 *All Claims for loss, damage or overcharge must be written and should be attached to the Bill of Lading.*
- 3.1.2 *Claimant must notify carrier of all claims for concealed damage within 15 days of the move. Bill Sanders Moving Inc. must be given reasonable opportunity to inspect damaged items.*
- 3.1.3 *Although our movers will be careful with your possessions, from time to time damages may occur. If damages are caused by our service, Bill Sanders Moving Inc. reserves the right to repair the damage(s) in question. If we determine that damages cannot be repaired, we reserve the right to either replace or compensate for the damage. If there is damage, notify Bill Sanders Moving Inc. immediately. They will complete a damage report before they leave your site. If you discover damage after the move, call the office, within 15 days of your move. No damage claims will be honored until the charges for moving services are paid in full. You will be asked to sign a Release of Liability acknowledging this.*

3.2 COMPUTING CHARGES

Bill Sanders Moving Inc. rates are computed by multiplying the applicable hourly rate by the time as provided in Section 1.

3.3 GOVERNING PUBLICATIONS

Bill Sanders Moving Inc. rates and charges are governed by the terms and conditions of this tariff, and the Rules and Regulations of the South Carolina Public Service Commission.

3.4 ITEMS OF PARTICULAR VALUE

Bill Sanders Moving Inc. does not assume any liability whatsoever for documents, currency, credit cards, jewelry, watches, precious stones or articles of extraordinary value including accounts, bills, deeds, evidences of debt, securities, notes, postage stamps, stamp collections, coin collections, trading stamps, revenue stamps, letters or packets of letters, alcoholic beverages, controlled substances, firearms, articles of peculiarly inherent or intrinsic value, precious metals or articles manufactured there from. Bill Sanders Moving Inc. will not accept responsibility for safe delivery of such articles if they come into Bill Sanders Moving Inc.'s possession with or without Bill Sanders Moving Inc.'s knowledge.

3.5 BILL OF LADING, CONTRACT TERMS, AND CONDITIONS

Each customer will be provided with a copy of Bill Sanders Moving Inc.'s Bill of Lading. The terms and conditions of the Bill of Lading, attached hereto, are hereby incorporated by reference.

3.6 DELAYS

Bill Sanders Moving Inc. shall not be liable for any delays in transporting household goods resulting from an act of God or fault or neglect of any unforeseen entities.

SECTION 4

4.0 PROMOTIONS

Bill Sanders Moving Inc. does not offer promotional rates of normal hourly service charges for moving, packing, and unpacking items listed in Section 1 or Section 2 to customers who are active duty military, disabled veterans, or senior citizens. All charges and fees will be uniform and nondiscriminatory for all customers of Bill Sanders Moving Inc.
