This matter comes before the Public Service Commission of South Carolina (“Commission”) on the Application of R & M Charlotte LLC d/b/a Two Men and a Truck of Charlotte (“Applicant” or “R&M”) for a Class E (Household Goods) Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity. The Applicant seeks authority to move household goods in South Carolina between points and places in Chester, Lancaster, and York Counties. Notice of this matter was timely published pursuant to 10 S.C. Code Ann. Regs. 103-817(C)(3)(a). No parties intervened, and a hearing on the Application was held on September 21, 2016, in the offices of the Commission.

The parties at the hearing included the Applicant, represented by John J. Pringle, Jr., Esquire, and the Office of Regulatory Staff (“ORS”), represented by Andrew M. Bateman, Esquire. The Applicant presented the direct testimony of William M. “Trip” Moore, III, the Managing Member of R&M. Mr. Moore testified as to the history of his company and its record as a motor carrier in North Carolina, as well as to its intent to comply with all applicable laws and regulations in South Carolina, and provided a Final

Tariff and Bill of Lading. ORS submitted the affidavit of L. George Parker, Transportation Manager, attesting to his inspection of the Applicant, and to his opinion that the Applicant met the requirements to be deemed fit, willing, and able to perform household goods moves in South Carolina.

The Commission finds the Application to be in order. Additionally, we conclude that the Applicant has demonstrated that it is fit, willing, and able to operate as a household goods mover pursuant to S.C. Code Ann. § 58-23-330 and 10 S.C. Code Ann. Regs. 103-133. Furthermore, we find that the public convenience and necessity is not already being served by existing authorized service. Therefore, the Application of R & M CHARLOTTE LLC D/B/A TWO MEN AND A TRUCK OF CHARLOTTE should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. The Application of R & M Charlotte LLC d/b/a Two Men and a Truck of Charlotte for a Class E (Household Goods) Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity is approved for the Applicant to transport household goods between points and places in Chester, Lancaster, and York Counties in South Carolina.

2. The Final Tariff and Bill of Lading are approved and attached hereto as Order Appendix A.

3. The Applicant shall file with the Office of Regulatory Staff the proper insurance, safety rating, and other information required by S.C. Code Ann. Section 58-23-10 et. seq. (1976), as amended, and by 10 S.C. Code Ann. Regs. 103-100 through 103-241 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations for Motor Carriers, as amended, and 2 S.C. Code Ann. Regs. 38-400 through 38-503 (Supp. 2015) of the Department of Public Safety's

Rules and Regulations for Motor Carriers, as amended, within ninety (90) days of the date of this Order, or within such additional time as may be authorized by the Commission.

4. Upon compliance with S.C. Code Ann. Section 58-23-10 et. seq. (1976), as amended, and the applicable Regulations for Motor Carriers, S.C. Code Ann. Regs. Vol. 10 (1976), as amended, a Certificate shall be issued by the Office of Regulatory Staff authorizing the motor carrier services granted herein.

5. Prior to compliance with the above-referenced requirements and receipt of a Certificate, the motor carrier services authorized by this Order shall not be provided.

6. Failure of the Applicant to either (1) comply with all statutory and regulatory requirements within ninety (90) days of the date of this Order, or (2) request and obtain from the Commission additional time to comply with the requirements, shall result in this Order granting the Application to become null and void and the Application shall be dismissed without prejudice. In this event, no further order of this Commission is necessary.

7. Pursuant to the two-month reporting requirement contained in Order No. 2014-443 (May 21, 2014), the ORS is requested to furnish the name and docket number of the Applicant to the Commission, should the Applicant fail to meet the requirements of the present Order. After such notification, the Docket shall be closed.


8. This Order shall remain in full force and effect until further order of the Commission.



TARIFF FORMAT

- A. **Page Numbering** - Page numbers appear in the upper-right corner of the page. Pages are numbered sequentially. New pages may occasionally be added to the tariff. When a new page is added, the page appears as a decimal. For example, a new page added between pages 3 and 4 would be 3.1.
- B. **Page Revision Numbers**. Page Revision Numbers also appear in the upper-right corner of the page. These numbers are used to determine the most current page revision on file with the South Carolina Public Service Commission. For example, the Fourth Revised Page 3 cancels the Third Revised Page 3.
- C. **Paragraph Numbering Sequence**. There are nine levels of paragraph coding. Each level of coding is subservient to its next higher level of coding.

This tariff contains the regulations and rates applicable to the provision of intrastate household goods moves by R&M Charlotte, L.L.C. These services are furnished between points and places in Chester, Lancaster, and York Counties.

SECTION 1 - TRANSPORTATION CHARGES

1 Transportation Charges include the hourly rates as listed below.

1.1 Hourly Rates and Charges

1.1.1 Moves up to 35 miles

For moves up to 35 miles, the Company will charge a two (2) hour minimum and one (1) hour of travel time. After the first hour, the hourly rates are calculated in fifteen-minute increments. Any interim charge is rounded up to the next fifteen-minute increment. If customers cancel within 48 hours of their move, the Company will charge a two-hour minimum fee.

1.1.2 Moves over 35 miles

For moves over 35 miles, moves will be conducted on a "straight time" basis, with a two-hour minimum plus estimated travel time. After the first two hours, the hourly rates are calculated in -fifteen minute increments. Any interim charge is rounded up to the next fifteen-minute increment. If customers cancel within 48 hours of their move, the Company will charge a two-hour minimum.

1.1.3 Hourly rates are the same, seven days a week, 24 hours a day, in every season of the year.

1.1.4 Customers are not charged an additional fee for overtime labor.

SECTION 2 - ADDITIONAL SERVICES

- 2 The following provisions apply to moves and additional services performed by the Company in connection with a move. The Company reserves the right to decline, at its sole discretion, to move particular items because of their bulk or fragile nature.
- 2.1. Elevator or Stair Carry
- The Company does not charge an additional fee for elevator or stair carry.
- 2.2. Excessive Distance or Long Carry Charges
- The Company does not charge an additional fee for carrying articles an excessive distance from the motor vehicle.
- 2.3. Packing and Unpacking
- The Company does not charge an additional fee for packing and unpacking. The packing rate is the same as the hourly rate listed in Section 1.1 plus the market price of packing materials, including sales tax on the materials.
- The Company is not responsible for items packed by the customer. Boxes containing fragile or breakable items must be properly labeled.
- 2.4. Labor Charges
- Labor charges are based on hourly rates as listed in Section 1.1. The applicable rate is multiplied by the number of hours.
- 2.5. Pick-Up and Delivery, Extra
- The Company does not charge an additional fee for making additional pick-ups or deliveries after the initial stop.

SECTION 2 - ADDITIONAL SERVICES (cont'd)

2.6. Waiting Time

The shipper is charged the rates specified in Section 1.1 for all waiting time or delays not the fault of the carrier.

2.7. Articles, Special Servicing

The rates and charges in this tariff do not include servicing or unservicing articles or appliances such as freezers, refrigerators, computer equipment, washers, dryers, televisions, and similar articles. The Company does not disconnect or reconnect the shipper's appliances and articles.

2.8. Overnight Storage Charges for Items on Trucks

Overnight storage charges will be incurred in the event the Company stores items on a truck at a rate of \$150/truck/night.

SECTION 3 - RULES AND REGULATIONS

3.1 Claims

- 3.1.1 All claims for loss, damage or overcharge must be written and should attach the bill of lading.
- 3.1.2 Claimant must immediately notify carrier of all claims for concealed damage. Carrier must be given reasonable opportunity to inspect damaged items in original packing.
- 3.1.3 Claims should be submitted to the carrier within 96 hours of receipt of goods.

3.2 Computing Charges

The Company's rates are computed by multiplying the applicable hourly rate by the time as provided in Section 1.1

3.3 Governing Publications

The Company's rates and charges are governed by the terms and conditions of this tariff, and the Rules and Regulations of the South Carolina Public Service Commission.

3.4 Storage-in-Transit

Carrier will require payment when a shipment is delivered to a temporary storage warehouse. Charges are calculated as provided in Section 1.
