
This matter comes before the Public Service Commission of South Carolina (“Commission”) for consideration of the provision of 26 S.C. Code Ann. Regs. 103-845 (C) (Supp. 2008) that requires the filing of twenty-five (25) copies of testimony and exhibits in proceedings before the Commission, unless otherwise specified. We believe that the filing of twenty-five (25) copies is no longer necessary. This practice is especially burdensome for *pro se* litigants, and most utility companies file their materials electronically. Accordingly, we hold that parties to proceedings before this Commission shall only be required to file one (1) original copy of testimony and exhibits with this Commission.
