DOCKET NO. 2004-359-C
Pursuant to South Carolina Code Annotated Section 58-9-310 and the regulations of the Public Service Commission (the Commission) SBC Telecom, Inc. (SBC or Assignor) and its affiliate Southwestern Bell Communications Services, Inc. d/b/a SBC Long Distance (SBCLD or Assignee) filed a Joint Petition (Petition) with the Commission for consent to and approval of the assignment of SBC's Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide local exchange and interexchange services from SBC to SBCLD as part of a corporate reorganization whereby direct ownership of SBCLD will transfer from SBC Communications, Inc. (SBC) to SBCT, all SBC assets will be transferred to SBCLD, and SBCT will cease operations. Additionally, SBCLD requests approval, to the extent such approval is required, to convert to a limited liability company to be known as SBC Long Distance, LLC d/b/a SBC Long Distance. SBCT was issued a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity by the Commission on May 23, 2000, to provide interexchange and local exchange telecommunications in Order No. 2000-446 (Docket No. 2000-44-C). SBCLD was issued a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity by the Commission on January 26, 1998, to provide resold interexchange telecommunications service in Order No. 1998-45 (Docket No. 1997-313-C) and was issued a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide facilities-based and resold local exchange telecommunications service on June 30, 2004, in Order No. 2004-228 (Docket No. 2003-361-C). The Petition also requests, among other things, that the Commission consent to and approve the assignment to SBCLD of SBC's interconnection agreement with BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. and consent and approval by the Commission of the transfer to and adoption by SBCLD of SBC's current filed tariffs. The Petition also requests that the Commission require the submission to the Commission of a revised SBCLD tariff reflecting SBCLD's name change.
